Inviting us to fully experience the Eucharistic rendez-vous which is Holy Communion, Peter Vigne, quotes Psalm 111. "I must focus my attention completely on the One I am about to receive". Such was the attitude of the disciples of Emmaus, in the attention they paid to their travelling companion who explained the Scriptures to them, revealing himself to his two disciples. The great Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, "Corpus Christi" celebrates and proclaims the real Presence of the Risen Christ in the Eucharist. living Bread..."

His tomb in the church of BOUCIEU LE ROI attracts pilgrims and tourists who come from many parts of the world and leave behind messages, which show that the little village Church is rich in encounters. Blessed Peter Vigne must be rejoicing and giving thanks for being in some way instrumental in opening the door for the "rendez-vous"! Here are some extracts:

"I have such a lovely souvenir of the Church of my childhood. Yes, I used to come here to pray, to seek peace and to lovingly remember all those who welcomed me to Boucieu. I was a child who found a family here, with them! MA"
