

A humble gift from God

Father Vigne is highly appreciated in the dioceses where bishops and priests call on him for long missions. When he visits the parishioners, he doesn't do it to be recognized as a valued missionary, or as one who is "obligated" to do so... He comes as a friend, in all simplicity, interested in the ordinary events of daily life, and he responds to their openness with a genuine

interest that engages him and probably upsets him at times! He doesn't present himself as someone who is cold and distant, expecting high honour and homage! He is the "good" Father Vigne, busy serving rather than being served...

His evaluations at the end of his missions, show that he has no secret desire to be praised or applauded by those who welcome him, even if important people sometimes offered him hospitality. But, he is also familiar with uncertainty and doubt as to where he would find lodgings



or even somewhere to eat. For example: at "Marie Prieure's almost every day was a fast day...", and that for a whole month! He could certainly have gone elsewhere, to those who were in a position to offer him gifts! But on the contrary, he pays his hostess and leaves her "several bottles of wine, a few small presents, fruit...", precisely by way of gratitude for the simplicity and poverty of the welcome! He does not expect gifts but becomes a "gift from God" for those who are forgotten, alone or infirm...

After a month-long mission in Chalencon, he noted: "I received nothing from this mission; on the contrary, I paid about 17# towards the cost" To those in need he gives generously: "to Catin I gave 10 sols (copper or silver coins) and a pair of good shoes...". Although he mentions it in his Memoir, he is careful not to publish it! He lives what he prays: "a hope founded on good works...an unending love for one's neighbour".

He contemplates the human face of God in the person of Jesus whose love manifested in the Eucharist, is the source and summit all his missionary activity: " *Grant me O Lord*, **an ardent love for you**, a deep **unending love for my neighbour** whom you love, and who is made in your image and likeness"

Praying with Peter Vigne will help us face the challenges of 2023 and lead to wholeness and PEACE despite its sombre beginnings.
