Of these 165 sisters, 105 died in Brazil..."





eter Vigne's life which began on August 20, 1670 is like a long unfolding love story. He was baptised on 20-24 August

8 July Peter Vigne

August 24 and later he became involved in special parish events at a very difficult period, still scarred by the hostilities that marked the wars of religion. Nothing could be further from Christian love. Despite that, or perhaps because of it, a significant event will turn the life of this young man upside down: an encounter with Christ, with his Eucharistic Presence. This event will mark him for the rest of his life. It will change his outlook, his values and his future. Peter Vigne knows that he is deeply loved by God, that he is sent and that God is always with him. Having experienced the loving presence of God and become a priest and missionary, he devotes his life to preaching and witnessing to God's love with eagerness and generosity. Durand, a member of municipal administration of Privas wrote: "we found him to be above all animated by zeal and Christian charity which wins hearts to God". Peter Vigne is familiar with a world torn apart by violence, poverty and the pain of families marked by ignorance. In his preaching and missions his sole desire was to ensure that the love of God is known, because "this love gives value to all our actions, even the most insignificant! It is like gold that makes all things beautiful and precious wherever it is found". That was what he experienced and demonstrated in all the villages and hamlets where he preached the Good News. Following his death in Rencurel on July 8, 1740 a witness wrote "people were drawn to him by his humility...he had amazing strength and courage....we must not forget to mention his charity, the greatest of all his virtues". His "charity", nourished daily by the Eucharist, the Sacrament of Love made every heartfelt response "radiant and precious in the eyes of God"

On July 8 the Church gives thanks to God for Blessed Peter Vigne, "priest, missionary and founder" and prays: "Father, all-powerful and ever-living God, we do well always and everywhere to give you thanks.

You give the Church this feast in honour of Blessed Peter Vigne; you inspire us by his holy life, instruct us by his preaching, and give us your protection in answer to his prayers"

The Church recognizes that he is a witness and that he "teaches" us today as he did three centuries ago! This leaflet "Reflections" allows us to simply disseminate this teaching. It can help us live and nourish our Christian life at any time of the year!

Pierre Vigne is an intercessor: "in answer to his prayer, you give us your protection". Let us entrust our intentions to him.....

He will present them to the Lord.

Blessed Feter Vigne, pray for us.....guide us.
